

Actor-Producer Kim Berrios Lin Breaks Out in Leading Role as Three Films Hit the Festival Circuit

NYC - NJ - ATL [May 4, 2026] — Actor-producer Kim Berrios Lin, known for her major recurring role as Lea Salonga's wife and Malia Pyle's Mom in *Pretty Little Liars: Original Sin*, steps into the spotlight this festival season with a powerful leading performance in *America*, a short film written and directed by Laura New, and EP'd by Vanessa Hudgens, that confronts the realities of school shootings in America. The role marks one of Berrios Lin's most meaningful performances to date, anchoring the film with emotional depth and urgency. *America* premiered at the Sunscreen Film Festival May 3rd and will screen at Jersey Shore Film Festival Jun 4th.

Alongside her on-screen work, Berrios Lin and her production company And She Flew® produced *Joan's Teeth*, starring Kathleen Turner, premiering at the Big Apple Film Festival May 11th, and screening at Jersey Shore Film Festival June 6th. The film is written by Dipti Brahmandkar, directed by Padraic Lillis, produced with Coley Company, and executive producer Lauren Zarelli Renaud. Shot in New Jersey with a New York

City-based cast and crew, the project reflects Berrios Lin's continued commitment to character-driven storytelling and regional filmmaking communities. The production boasted a community effort, with local businesses participating, including associate producer Veronica Kautz of Scotch Plains City Lifestyle.

Berrios Lin also appears in a supporting role in feature 'Third', which premiered at the Atlanta Film Fest April 24th, starring longtime collaborators Alex Parkinson (writer/director) and Coley Company, as well as Norio Nishimura, where she takes on a comedic turn as an offbeat police officer—showcasing her range across both dramatic and comedic work.

Additional projects are currently in development, including a high-profile documentary soon to be announced, a feature 'Ride or Die': winner of best screenplay at Atlanta Film Festival - producing alongside Alex Parkinson (writer), Coley Company, Nick Ditri, and Veronica Kautz, and a narrative project in development with Joshua Schubert.

Beyond her film work, Berrios Lin is the founder of And She Flew® and serves on the advisory board of Applaud Our Kids, a nonprofit providing sustained, tuition-free arts education to financially qualifying youth across New Jersey.

A longtime New York City based actor, Berrios Lin now resides in New Jersey, with creative roots in Atlanta, where she balances her career with raising two children. In addition to her work in film and advocacy, she is also the inventor of a three-time patented yoga product, Yogisaver® - the 1st ever product to be rolled with one's yoga mat during storage to prevent bacterial growth and absorb excess moisture - patents are currently available for purchase and licensing.

First and foremost an actor, Kim Berrios Lin brings depth and range to every role, while also producing projects that reflect her commitment to bold, socially conscious storytelling.
